**Riverside Drive Bridge near Zoo Drive over Los Angeles River Project**  
**Los Angeles River Bike Path Detour through November 2019**

<b>What's happening</b>	<p>Closure of a one-mile segment of the Los Angeles River Bike Path.</p> <p>The Los Angeles River Bike Path improvements include constructing an underpass along the south channel wall and accessible connections to both sides of Riverside Drive. An additional 400 feet of bike path will be added along the Los Angeles River.</p> <p>The Riverside Drive Bridge will be widened by 19 feet on the downstream (east) side to accommodate four 11 foot lanes, a 2 foot median, two 5 foot shoulders, two 8 foot sidewalks, and two 1 foot barrier railings.</p>
<b>Where</b>	The Los Angeles River Bike Path east of Riverside Drive. The entrance to the bike path at Riverside Drive and SR-134 will be closed.
<b>When</b>	The closure will be in effect through November 2019. Construction and closure schedules are subject to change.
<b>Why</b>	The bike path in this area passes through an active construction zone where bridge widening is underway. The closure is a safety measure to protect bike path users.
<b>Detour</b>	A signed detour is posted that directs bike path users to exit at Zoo Drive and Western Heritage Way. See back of this flyer for map.
<b>Safety Measures</b>	Traveling public will be redirected to one side of the bridge (east side for stage one and west side for stage two). There will be K-Rails, signs, and barricades to help direct and protect the motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists.
